## This funding will be used to

- **To improve reading outcomes for all students.**
  - To ensure that the school reading targets are attained:
    - 95% of all students achieve A – C in English
    - National Assessment Program – Literacy and Numeracy (NAPLAN) – reading – (Year 3 & 5) all students are at or above Australian Mean Scale Score (MSS), 50% of students achieving in the Upper 2 Bands (U2Bs).
    - 80% of all P – 3 students achieving school reading targets with 25% of these students achieving above these targets

## Our initiatives include

- Review student performance data every 5 weeks
- Principal to meet with teachers twice per term to discuss and analyse individual student reading progress and set targets for each student based on above data collection
- Principal and staff review and refine the implementation of the whole-school reading program
- Build teacher and teacher aide capacity in the teaching of reading and literacy
- Build teacher capacity in explicit teaching and consolidations through coaching and feedback
- Classroom observations (during reading groups and literacy time) in every classroom once per term
- Ensure students have access to engaging texts

## Our school will improve student outcomes by

- Literacy Support (Teacher Aides to assist in the P – 6 classrooms 5 mornings a week to implement explicitly taught reading groups and literacy programs. \$35 p/h x 20 hours p/w x 36 weeks p/y (\$25200).
- Release classroom teachers to review and refine whole school reading program and conduct individual class data and goal setting meetings (4 x Teacher Relief Scheme [TRS] \$450 = \$1800)
- Release teaching principal/senior experienced teacher to conduct observations, coaching and feedback (2 x TRS \$450 = \$900)
- Purchase sets of reading books and increase number of existing sets of readers for reading groups \$3355
