

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Silkwood State School Dress Code

Our school dress code outlines what students may wear to school and what is acceptable to the Silkwood School Community with regard student attire. This code has been produced in consultation with staff, parents and P&C so that all Silkwood State School students represent their school and community with pride and respect. These compulsory uniform standards also meet comfort and Education Queensland workplace health and safety requirements.

Our uniform shop is run by the P&C and all items apart from shoes may be purchased upon request or appointment. Assistance is available for families who may find it difficult to afford new uniforms for their children. Enquiries can be made at the school office.

Uniform Standards

- Polo-neck t-shirt (black and emerald green)
- Black shorts or skorts to at least mid-thigh length
- Wide-brimmed hat
- Closed in shoes
- Sports shirt for sports events and Friday HPE lessons:
 - Barnard House (blue & black polo-neck t-shirt)
 - Ellison House (gold & black polo-neck t-shirt)

Please note:

- Unless otherwise specified, the accepted school uniform should be worn by students traveling to and from school, whilst representing the school and during school activities
- Students must wear an appropriate hat while in the sun
- No jewellery apart from a wrist watch or sleepers/studs may be worn at school. Please contact the principal if jewellery is required for medical, religious or cultural reasons.
- Students are not permitted to wear make up
